The problem about unstable Wi-Fi connection at your place will be solved, if you follow these simple steps on how to boost your Wi-Fi signal. The first and probably the easiest way is to move your router to a central location. Like talking or shouting, walls, objects, and overall distance will all negatively affect signal strength. You should try to position your router within an open and central location in your house away from walls and other dense objects that might obstruct the signal from reaching the far corners of your living room and other parts of your home. Placing a router in an upstairs or downstairs corner is going to result in a weaker signal at the opposite end of your house. Next, you should get your router off the floor and let it breathe. Placing a router on the floor or putting mountains of stuffs, such as papers or clothes, on it can decrease the Wi-Fi connection strength. You should make sure that your router is not only uplifted, but is in an open space. In other words, you must try to avoid putting it in an enclosed space, like the back portion of a bookshelf. Finally, the most important thing you can do to boost your Wi-Fi signal is to keep your router away from other electronic devices. It's always a smart idea to keep your router as far away from other electronic devices as possible, particularly devices that transmit information at 2.4 GHz. Make a point to keep your router at a safe distance from microwaves, cordless phones, video game controllers, TV remotes, and baby monitors. Failing to do so can result in a noticeable downgrading of Wi-Fi strength. By following these easy steps, the unstable Wi-Fi connection will not be your
